Projects to be financed by CNPq will be supported under the modality APQ (Individual Grant for Research – regulations available at: http://www.cnpq.br/web/guest/view/-/journal_content/56_INSTANCE_0oED/10157/25480#rn17114 and must be submitted by the Brazilian coordinator to the Carlos Chagas Platform <http://carloschagas.cnpq.br/> subsequently to their approval.

All criteria for the APQ modality must be complied with otherwise the proposals will not be submitted to meritorious evaluation.

Who can apply?

- Researchers from higher education institutions, public or private (if non-profit);
- Researchers from R&D institutes and centres, public or private (if non-profit);
- Researchers from public companies that carry out activities of research in S&T&I

The research project coordinator for the Brazilian side must hold a Doctoral Degree and have a Lattes Curriculum <http://lattes.cnpq.br/> up-to-date until the final deadline.

What types of costs are eligible for funding?

According to RN-17/2011:

- Direct Costs
 - a) Consumable materials;
 - b) Air Tickets and per diems.

- Indirect Costs
- a) Third party services both natural and legal persons.

Expenses not covered by the specific call will be of responsibility of the project coordinator and/or the project implementing institution.

Upper funding limits for eligible costs?

- **Biorefinery: Intermediate and/or high added value bioproducts** (100.000,00 Euros, which will be allocated in until four (4) 25.000,00 Euros projects);
- **ICT for urban sustainability: nature-based solutions, citizen, science and systemic urban planning** (100.000,00 Euros, which will be allocated in until four (4) 25.000,00 Euros projects);
- **Infectious diseases: early detection research including both screening and diagnosis** (100.000,00 Euros, which will be allocated in until four (4) 25.000,00 Euros projects).
