

## NATIONAL REGULATIONS OF FUNDING PARTIES

Applicants will be advised to check with the respective national Call Contact Person the eligibility as to who may apply and what costs are eligible before a consortium submits the complete application.

### Who can apply?

- Research organisations;
- Enterprises (micro, small, medium).

Organisation must be registered in Poland.

### What types of costs are eligible for funding?

1. Personnel costs (W) = researchers, technicians and other supporting staff to the extent employed on the research project;
2. Costs of instruments, equipment (A) and intangible assets (such as patents, certificates etc. purchased or used under the license obtained from the third party according to market conditions) to the extent and for the period used for the research project; if they are not used for their full life for the research project, only the depreciation costs corresponding to the life of the research project, as calculated on the basis of good accounting practice, shall be considered eligible; It is possible one-off amortization according to national regulations.
3. Purchase of land and real estates (G) to the extent and for the period used for the research project; with regard to real estates, only the depreciation costs corresponding to the life of the research project, as calculated on the basis of good accounting practice shall be considered eligible; for land, costs of commercial transfer or actually incurred capital costs shall be eligible;
4. Costs of subcontracting (E), i.e. costs based on agreements with third parties to perform a portion of the project without a direct supervision of the project participant and without a

relationship of subordination the subcontracting can be obtained from consortium partner only in justified case, this need will be verified by a national experts panel; Costs of subcontracting cannot exceed 70% of all eligible costs of the project.

5. Other costs (Op) = including costs of support services, materials, supplies and similar products incurred directly as a result of the research activity, travel costs (costs of delegations, costs of participation in conferences), costs of maintaining a separate bank account, costs of promoting the project;
6. Overheads (O) = incurred indirectly as a result of the research project; Overheads must be calculated according to the formula:  

$$O = (W+A+G+Op) \times \text{up to } 25\%^*$$

\* percentage from 0% to 25% estimated by the Applicant himself (the same percentage for every task in the project)

### Upper funding limits for eligible costs?

Upper funding limits for eligible costs for Polish participants: **€ 80 000/per project**.

The NCBR's total allocation for the ERANet-LAC 3rd Multi-Thematic Joint Call 2017/2018 is **€ 640 000**.

NCBR plans to fund **8 projects** in the ERANet-LAC 3rd Multi-Thematic Joint Call 2017/2018.

The maximum duration of a project is **36 months**.

Polish applicants can submit project proposals in the following topics:

- Observatories' network on biodiversity and climate change: Coordinating data acquisition and fostering data access and transfer,
- Biorefinery: Intermediate and/or high added value bioproducts,
- ICT platform for Learning and Inclusion,
- ICT for urban sustainability: Nature-based Solutions, citizen science and systemic urban planning.

Funding quota of Polish participants can be up to 100% for research organisations. In the case of enterprises, funding quota will be decided on a case-by-case basis depending on the size of the company, type of research/development, risk associated with the research activities and commercial perspective of exploitation. Organisation must be registered in Poland.

In the ERANet-LAC 3rd Multi-Thematic Joint Call 2017/2018 the following types of research/development are eligible:

- Industrial/Applied research: for research organisations, enterprises (micro, small, medium),
- Experimental development: for research organisations, enterprises (micro, small, medium).

The state aid intensity is presented in the table below:

**Additional national eligibility criteria for the proposal beyond the general criteria in the Terms of Reference of the Joint Transnational Call**

All proposals must be aligned with national regulations, inter alia:

- The Act of 30 April 2010 on the Principles of Financing Science (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2016 item 2045, as amended)
- The Act of 30 April 2010 on the National Centre for Research and Development (consolidated text: Journal of Laws of 2017, item 1447, as amended)
- The Regulation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 25 February 2015 on criteria and rules on granting state aid and de minimis aid through the National Centre for Research and Development (Journal of Laws of 2015, item 299).
